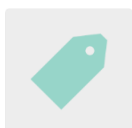

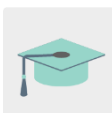

Irakasleek [Europako Historiaren Etxearen Fake for Real](#) erakustaldi birtualera gonbidatuko dituzte ikasleak, Europako historiari buruzko ikuspegi eta interpretazio aniztasunaren inguruan sentsibilizatzea helburu duena. Museoko bisita birtuala nazioarteko taldeetan egingo da. Ikasleek Europako historiaren etapa desberdinetako bideoak ikusiko dituzte, faltsifikatzea ez dela batere berria erakusten dutenak. Bideoak ikusi eta gero, ikasleek titular bat sortuko dute euren nazioarteko taldeei dagokien etapa definitzeko.

4. urratsa: Zeregina nazioarteko taldeetan antolatzea

Irakasle batek orri honetan taula bat txertatuko du nazioarteko taldeak sortzeko. Taulan, aukeratu beharreko gaiak, etapa historiko bakoitzeko bideoetarako esteka eta ikasleen taldekatzea jasoko dira. 
