Difficulty: intermediate



2 partners



Duration: 6 sessions

Tags: security, privacy, digital gap, media and communication, disinformation, critical spirit

DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY:

Students plan and organize a round table on digital transformation and cybersecurity in the post-COVID era that includes the participation of school council members, representatives from local educational authorities or alumni working in the media, for example, along with the student body itself.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To improve group work when learning
- 2. To encourage the active participation of the educational community in individual and group reflection, to respect others' opinions and to enhance a critical spirit
- 3. To provide students with opportunities to improve organization and planning

KEY COMPETENCES AND CROSSCUTTING THEMES:

- Linguistic competence
- Data processing and digital competence
- Social and civic competences
- Learning how to learn
- Moral and civic education
- Media education

CURRICULAR CONTENT:

- Recognizing the inherent structure of a debate: the moderator's role, regulated timing, speaking in turns and using appropriate language
- Looking for information and improving the ability to organize and transform said information. Analysis and synthesis of data

INCLUSIVITY:

Through a debate and the interaction of members from the educational community, it will be possible to identify barriers that some groups come across when they try to access educational opportunities. The aim is to guarantee equal opportunities for all.

EXPECTED FINAL PRODUCTS / RESULTS:

- Script for the moderator
- Event dissemination material: invitations, posters and press release
- Audiovisual presentation of the debate: recording, live broadcast

CARRYING OUT THE ACTIVITY



Preparation

Step 1: The participating teachers create a profile for each student in the TwinSpace.

Step 2: Icebreakers

One of the participating teachers creates an activity page on TwinSpace entitled 'ActYourRole at the ROUND TABLE' that includes a link to the digital whiteboard (using <u>Jamboard</u> or a similar tool) with an icebreaker activity in which the participating students answer the question 'How much do you know about King Arthur?' This page also includes a document with the distribution of the teams and a debate, as shown in the following steps.

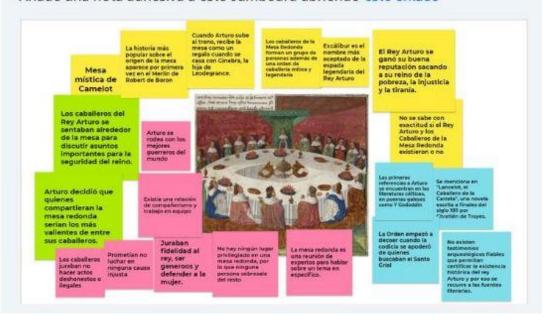
MESA REDONDA

Una mesa redonda es un encuentro entre varias personas sobre un asunto de interés común. Entre los participantes de una mesa redonda no existen diferencias jerárquicas (todos se encuentran en la misma posición a la hora de aportar sus opiniones y conocimientos).

Round tables: The premise on which the idea of roundtables is based is simple – participants, be they business people, local authority employees, environmentalists, members of community-based organisations or members of the public, are seen as being of equal stature. (Day et al 1998)

Step 3: International teams

One of the participating teachers posts the document with the distribution of the students in four mixed international teams to the previously-created page (*ActYourRole at the ROUND TABLE'*) and prepares the round table. Teachers and students come up with a table that includes the possible roles they are going to act out and the tasks they are going to carry out (eg. developing the topic, sending invitations, broadcasting the event, recording or promoting it). Students are distributed according to their abilities and interests. Each partner school coordinates two teams and encourages participation in the activities (preferably with two teachers in the project from each school). Alternatively, the number of teams may vary depending on the number of participating teachers.



Step 4: Proposals for debate topics

One of the teachers finishes preparing the 'ActYourRole at the ROUND TABLE' page by starting a debate at the bottom of the page to introduce the topic: 'Has the pandemic made us better digital citizens?'

Note: Open debates on specific activity pages are displayed as threads in the 'page debates' section of the forums.



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Step 5: Preparing the round table

Each of the coordinating teachers from each international team creates a subpage of activities in the TwinSpace, under the main 'ActYourRole at the ROUND TABLE' page, using a title that best describes the role that their team will play in the preparation of the roundtable (eg., moderator, invitations, maintenance, promotion, schedule, etc.). The explanations of the activity and the working document for the team are also included, and the debate is initiated at the bottom of the page.




Step 6: The round table

Once the schedule has been agreed upon, the moderator's script has been prepared, the technical aspects have been tested and the event has been promoted, each of the partner schools hold a round table and invite other partners to watch the round table on streaming (on YouTube or a similar platform). To do this, one of the partner teachers creates a new page called 'Round Table: Results' and each partner edits the page to share the results as shown in step 7 below.

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Step 7: Results of the round table and dissemination

On the new page, 'Round Table: Results', one of the teachers includes a digital TwinBoard called 'Sharing results after the round table'. The students share each school's recordings of the round table, analyzes the round table of the partner school and summarizes it. An article is also drawn up that will be published on the school's website, in the local press or on the radio, etc.
