## eTwinning rooms: Join, connect, collaborate

<u>eTwinning rooms</u> are mini groups where you can exchange ideas, resources and experiences on specific topics. They are accessible through the **rooms** tab in the eTwinning area and can be open to the public or restricted.

## IN EACH ROOM, YOU CAN:

- Join discussions via forums
- Share documents and materials
- Attend live meetings using the Big Blue Button

## **WAYS TO USE THE ROOMS:**

- **Before and after Erasmus+ mobility activities**: connect with colleagues and organisations in advance of short-term mobilities (student exchanges, job-shadowing or teaching assignments) to organise the details, then use the room to share reflections and useful materials afterward.
- Training and professional development: follow up on learning experiences and collaborate with colleagues who participated in Erasmus+ courses or eTwinning professional development activities, both online and onsite.
- **Project planning**: develop ideas, plan activities and coordinate logistics with your partners before launching your eTwinning project or finalising your Erasmus+ application.

**Keep in mind:** Rooms are not the right space to search for partners or carry out your project activities – use <u>partner search</u> and the <u>TwinSpace</u> instead.

Go to <u>rooms</u> to explore current rooms or start your own. eTwinning rooms make collaboration easier, more focused and more flexible!
